**New Zealand Peace Flag:** The New Zealand 'peace celebrations' flag was originally presented to Lymington by departing soldiers in February 1919 to commemorate peace and the end of WW1.



Unfortunately the original flag could not be found so Mayor Anne Corbridge was formally presented with a replacement New Zealand peace flag by a senior New Zealand High Commission representative on 28th April 2019 in Brockenhurst at the ANZAC service. This replacement flag will be entrusted to St.Thomas Church, where it will hang with other standards during the Remembrance period each year.
