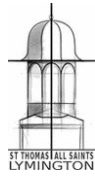

Love in a Box: we are pleased that this is able to continue so please leave any donations in the parish office. After checking our stock we will give a better guide to what is needed although gifts of money are always appreciated.

Basics Bank: they have three full containers within the Ampress self-storage estate and have decided to stop stockpiling any more ambient food as they have enough at present. Their referrals have decreased rapidly mainly due to the cessation of the self-isolating project sponsored by NFDC and a marked decrease in the number of school families they are helping in New Milton. They are working closely with the referral agencies to make sure they are not missing anyone.
