

Being With Course: Mondays 10:30-12:00 or Wednesdays 6-7:30. We are piloting the new Being With Course, developed this year at St Martin in the Fields. The ten work course starts week beginning 28th September running until end of November. This is an opportunity for those wishing to explore the Christian faith for the first time, those wishing to be baptised or Confirmed this year and those wanting to explore Christianity within the particular inclusive theology that we share. It's a ten week course on zoom. As we join the HeartEdge network, and are one of the few churches across the country that have been invited to pilot this course, we'd love you to join the conversation. Restored Lives: Are you or anyone you know struggling after a breakup? Starting 21st September there is an online course, Restored Lives At Home, eight sessions that support people to recover fully from the breakdown of a significant relationship. Each week explores a different issue including communication, conflict resolution, legal matters and co-parenting, looking at what the experts say then discussing the topic in a small group. We create a safe, non-judgemental space for people to meet others in similar situations and hear from people who have successfully moved on after a bad breakup. £20 registration fee includes a copy of the Restored Lives book and Guest Workbook which accompany the course.
