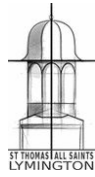

Restored Lives: Are you or anyone you know struggling after a breakup? Starting 21st September there is an online course, Restored Lives At Home, eight sessions that support people to recover fully from the breakdown of a significant relationship. Each week explores a different issue including communication, conflict resolution, legal matters and co-parenting, looking at what the experts say then discussing the topic in a small group. We create a safe, non-judgemental space for people to meet others in similar situations and hear from people who have successfully moved on after a bad breakup. £20 registration fee includes a copy of the Restored Lives book and Guest Workbook which accompany the course.
