Holy Week 2021 online: Our Holy Week reflections this year will be based on the Iona Community book, "Love is never done" by Neil Paynter. On Monday to Thursday evenings there will be Compline with a reflection from the book. You can join these services at 7pm on Zoom, Facebook and YouTube. On Good Friday, 2nd April, at 12 noon, Sarah will be leading an 'Ignatian meditation at the foot of the cross', again available on Zoom, Facebook or YouTube.

Holy Week 2021 in St.Thomas: the church will be open as usual for prayer, and there will also be tables where people will be able to sit and explore some questions relating to their experience of the pandemic, under the headings of 'Thanksgiving', 'Lament', 'Learning' and 'Prayer'. 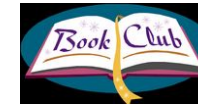
