Read the study passage: Luke 2:15-21

- Q6 What does the name Jesus mean?
- Q7 How do we see the significance of Jesus' name throughout the rest of his life?
- Q8 How do you understand the phrase: "But Mary treasured up all these things and pondered them in her heart"? (Lk 2:19, NIV) (See also 1:66 and 2:51)
- Q9 How do you relate to the words of John Newton's hymn opposite?
- Q10 Join together in the words of the Collect opposite, and close in prayer.





Naming and circumcision of Jesus

The Background

- Many Jews were looking for a political leader to deliver them from Roman rule, while others were hoping for a saviour to deliver them from sickness and physical hardship. Jesus was to be a very different saviour, born to deliver them from sin and death.
- Jesus was referred to equally as: 'the Christ' (Greek) and 'the Messiah' (Hebrew), both mean "the Anointed One".
- The name of Jesus.

How sweet the name of Jesus sounds in a believer's ear! It soothes his sorrows, heals his wounds, and drives away his fear.

It makes the wounded spirit whole, and calms the troubled breast; 'tis manna to the hungry soul, and to the weary rest.
