- Do you think this short passage indicates that Peter was a good orator or was this an example of the Holy Spirit providing the right words when he most needed them?
- Given that many of the people Peter was talking to were complicit in Jesus' crucifixion, why were they "cut to the heart?"
- Repentance accompanied by baptism promises the gift of the Holy Spirit. What was the gift for those who were baptized by John? What is the difference?
- What sort of healing do the passages allude to if any?
- **Read Mark 10 : 46 - 52**
- Do the actions of Timaeus indicate a high degree of faith or just desperation?
- Why was everyone keen to silence Timaeus? Surely they knew that Jesus treated everyone equally?
- Timaeus in the passage certainly does display faith in Jesus' ability to heal. What experience have you ever had of physical healing?
- What experience do you have of spiritual healing?
