Tuesday 29th August, 7.30pm: Institution Service for Lee Thompson – STC. Refreshments will be served following the service. All are welcome to attend. This service will be live streamed.

Livestreaming: We are pleased to announce that the livestreaming of the Sunday 9.15 service will recommence as from **Sunday 30th July**. From that date, 'considerate filming' of this service will take place. Care will be taken to ensure that only those in the Chancel area, (the area between the Altar and pulpit) who have given their permission to be filmed, will appear in shot. Filming will cease whilst people go forward into the Chancel area to receive Holy Communion. During other parts of the service, the backs of the heads of those sitting towards the front of the Nave may appear in shot. The film free zone, which will not be filmed, is the back 5 rows of the church. The service will appear on YouTube for a month after which time it will be removed.
