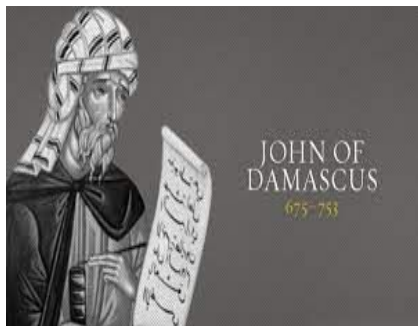

Sunday 13th August: We are delighted to have Nigel Bonard playing the organ today.

Monday 14th August: Funeral Service for the late Margaret Hellawell. 11.30am - STC

Tuesday 29th August, 7.30pm: Institution Service for Lee Thompson – STC. Light refreshments will be served following the service. All are welcome to attend. This service will be live streamed.

Livestreaming: We are pleased to announce that the livestreaming of the 9.15am services has recommenced with considerate filming taking place. Care will be taken to ensure that only those in the Chancel area, (the area between the Altar and pulpit) who have given their permission to be filmed, will appear in shot. Filming will cease whilst people go forward into the Chancel area to receive Holy Communion. During other parts of the service, the backs of the heads of those sitting towards the front of the Nave may appear in shot. The film free zone is the back 5 rows of the church. The service will appear on YouTube for a month after which time it will be removed.

Tower Works: You may have noticed that scaffolding has now been erected around the base of our tower. Our major maintenance project this year is to enable repairs to the masonry and upper woodwork and these will continue for several weeks.

Welcoming our new Bishop of Winchester: The Rt Reverend Philip Mounstephen has been appointed as the new Bishop of Winchester and will serve as the 98th Bishop of the Winchester Diocese, which covers 255 parishes across most of Hampshire and part of Dorset. He will be welcomed at a service of installation in Winchester Cathedral later this year.

Eco Church - Earth Overshoot Day: We have just passed [Earth Overshoot Day](#), which this year was on 2nd August. This is date when humanity has used up more resources than the planet's ecosystems can regenerate in a year. For the rest of 2023, we are effectively borrowing resources from future years. We've already passed the UK day, which was 19th May. To move the date, we need to tread more lightly and live within our ecological means, doing all the things encouraged by Eco Church. For example: **Diet-** Eat a planet friendly diet, buying from local, sustainable producers. **Voice-** Use your voice to demand change: vote, sign petitions, protest. **Energy-** Use energy sustainably and try to reduce the amount that is wasted.
