Ref V1 to V3

What do you think is meant by "the word?"

Ref V4 to V5

Do you think this statement is still valid today or are all the conflicts in the world evidence that the darkness might have overcome the light in some instances?

Ref V6 to V8

Why was it so important that John came to bear witness? After all, the things that Jesus did during his ministry were surely enough evidence that he was not an ordinary man?

Ref V9 to V11

There is a reasonable amount of evidence from the scriptures that people who witnessed Jesus' acts knew he had extraordinary powers. Why was it such a massive leap to accept he was the Son of God?

Ref V12 to V14

Some people have difficulty in accepting the whole concept of Christianity. Do you think that there is a sort of "elite club" that we join when we believe and everyone else is left out in the cold?
